

Delegation Order 1-15 (Formerly DO 110, Rev. 9)

Effective: December 20, 2007

(1) Waiving Claims Against Current or Former Employees for Erroneous Payments

(2) **Authority:** To waive, in whole or in part, a claim of the United States against a current or former employee for erroneous payment of pay and allowances, excluding travel, transportation and relocation expenses, aggregating less than \$5,000 per claim, and to deny requests for waiver in any amount.

(3) **Delegated to:** Director, Employee Support Services (Agency-Wide Shared Services) for payments to employees, except Chief Counsel employees; and Associate Chief Counsel (Finance and Management) for payments to Chief Counsel employees.

(4) **Redelegation:** This authority may not be redelegated.

(5) **Authority:** To waive, in whole or in part, a claim of the United States against a current or former employee for erroneous payment of travel, transportation, and relocation expenses and allowances aggregating less than \$5,000 per claim, and to deny requests for waiver in any amount.

(6) **Delegated to:** Deputy Chief Financial Officer.

(7) **Redelegation:** This authority may not be redelegated.

(8) **Sources of Authority:** Treasury Directive 34-01.

(9) To the extent that the authority previously exercised consistent with this order may require ratification, it is hereby approved and ratified. This order supersedes Delegation Order No. 110 (Rev. 9).
